



SyNA – NVR activities and outlook for 2017-18

SyNA – Systemisches Institut für Neue Autorität (English: Systemic Institute for New Authority) was founded by Bruno Körner and Martin Lemme in August 2012. They attended Haim Omer's first seminars in Osnabrück and have both been cooperating with him regularly ever since 2002.

Bruno Körner, Martin Lemme and their team participate in numerous in-house events. Most of the processes at the respective institutions, primarily youth welfare institutions, institutes of clinical child and youth psychiatry as well as day care centers and schools, run over a longer period of time. Lectures and workshops complement the broad range of offerings. So far, the two conferences with Haim Omer and colleagues at the Suitbertus-Gymnasium in Düsseldorf in March 2013 and at the University of Applied Sciences in Würzburg-Schweinfurt in December 2015 have been the highlights of SyNA. Moreover, several scientific publications have been published in the last few years.
