

PINA – NVR activities 2018

In 2017, Martin Fellacher dissolved with PINA (www.pina.at) from the former proprietors, the “Stiftung Jupident” and the “Vorarlberger Kinderdorf”. This caused an additional boost to different activities, especially in the means of trainings for professionals in western Austria and surroundings. The first certificate course in Vorarlberg finished in May in cooperation with “Systemische Akademie Bramsche”, and in October there were two trainings with Uri Weinblatt on shame, with a total of 50 participants.

Together with INA and SPES, a program for municipalities called “Couragierte Gemeinde” was further developed and is about to be offered to the administrations in 2018.

For 2018, Angela Eberding joined PINA and brings in her experience into the development and implementation of trainings and workshops. Substantively, the focus in trainings will be on intercultural settings, children with diagnoses, social media abuse, managers and compensation. A total of about 250 participants attended the PINA trainings this year, additional a lot of trainings and coaching in schools and institutions were held.

Since January 2018, we offer our services to the official youth welfare service as well. The impact of our interventions has already attracted interest among the professionals in the services.

For 2019, we plan the next big conference in Feldkirch with Haim Omer, Ben Furman (“Kid’s skills”), Maria Aarts (“MarteMeo”) and Liane Stephan (“Mindfulness”), trying to connect the different conceptions for the wealth of our clients.
